Because their farmer partners are paid Fair Trade prices above the market value for their crops, they are able to make investments in community projects, educational programs and technical trainings. These strong co-operative organizations also help keep rural communities healthy and strong, and keep local cultures vibrant. We currently have many different varieties of coffee available in the Narthex for \$10 per bag.
